



ABOUT CERAMIC & GLAZED LAVASTONE

Both ceramic as glazed lava stone possess excellent qualities for outdoor use. They are stain repellent, UV-stable and resistant to heat, frost, mould and mildew.

Our glazed lava stone tops, made of 400-year old lava stone, are finished by hand. As the pigments used to create the coloured glaze, change during the baking process of the stone, each top is unique.

The ceramics we selected all share an elegance in colour and are inspired by nature. As our table tops are cut out of large slabs, the pattern might differ from table to table.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- Cleaning should be done preferably during cloudy weather or in the shade. Make sure your furniture is cooled down before you start.
- Beware of sensitive flooring and wear protective gloves.
- Do not use any abrasive sponges, steel brushes, wonder sponge or any abrasive/caustic cleaner.
- Do not use a high pressure cleaner nor a steamer.
- Make sure your furniture is clean and completely dry before you apply protective products.

CLEANING

- Cleaning is simple with warm, clear water and a pH-neutral fluid detergent. Rinse with plenty of water, then dry with a clean microfiber cloth.
- Stubborn stains can be removed with **Glass & Ceramic Cleaner** (1). Shake the spray well and mist the surface evenly in one movement.
- Leave the product for one minute.
- If necessary, use a soft nail brush for stubborn stains or residue.
- Dry and polish with a clean microfiber cloth.

PROTECTING

- To protect your ceramic or glazed lava stone top, we recommend applying **Ceramic Protector** (2) once or twice a year, which will act as a conditioner, intensifying the colour and reducing the adhesion of dirt and stains.
- Make sure that the surface is completely clean, dust-free and dry before applying the product.
- Moisten a microfiber cloth with the Ceramic Protector and apply a layer to the surface, ensuring full and even coverage with fast circular movements.
- Allow the surface to dry for a few minutes and then polish the surface with a clean microfiber cloth.

STORAGE

Cover your table during the winter with one of our breathable covers to keep it clean and in top condition. If you prefer to store your table indoors, we recommend that you demount the tabletop from the base and place it upright on a soft surface. Always move the tabletop upright in a vertical position. We advise you to clean your table first and treat it with Ceramic Protector. Store only in a dry, unheated and well-ventilated room and never use non-breathable plastic covers.
